Well, thanks for reading.






of all shapes and sizes.

The Tasks

So, this is the meat in this proverbial sandwich... the GYØ Guided Tour!

LOCATION #1: The Lighthouse Café

Where: Market Gates, Great Yarmouth

Why: The Lighthouse Café is the starting of many great tasking exploits, and I believe THIS is where you should begin your guided tour, true GYØ style.

Notable tasks: Take It To The Steps Of City Hall, Campaign Trail (Adam), Photo Competition #1





Here, the It sits, waiting for a cup of tea, in the Lighthouse Café. It is a suitable environment for tea drinking or even political campaigning. Its scenic window provides an attractive view of the pigeon-scattered, gum-covered street below, as well as the gathering of youths outside McDonalds.

LOCATION #2: Market Gates Shopping Centre

Where: Market Gates, Great Yarmouth

Why: Market gates is a haven for unwitting Great Yarmouth non-SFØ players (which, judging by the amount of people signed up in GYØ, is probably less than half of the population of the town).

Notable tasks: High Fived, Audio Tour Series, Thank You The MGMT





This is the exterior of Market Gates. You can see the utterly 80s design patterns and fish emblems (because Great Yarmouth smells of fish – didn't you know?). Market Gates is the main shopping centre for Great Yarmouth (if a little small), and contains wonders such as Wilkinson's and Gamestation.

MOVE WEST TOWARD THE MARKET CENTRE

LOCATION #3: Marketplace

Where: King Street, Great Yarmouth

Why: The marketplace is the home of chips, tourists, pigeons, and chips. This was the setting for GYØ's real first tasking exploit: Bigger, Better or More Bizarre.

Notable tasks: Bigger, Better or More Bizarre, The Heist and Unorthodox Caroling (with Charlie Fish)





Here, we see one of the now legendary transfers in GYØ's history, the great Wpro trade. Wpro has now become a source of many jokes and references, and will remain with GYØ for a long time. In fact, the product itself remains in Ben's bedroom.

Here is a picture of a kitten because pictures of Great Yarmouth's marketplace are difficult to come by, and I needed a filler shot.

LOCATION #4: Multi-Storey Car Park

Where: Above Market Gates, Great Yarmouth

Why: Car parks seem to have a connection to GYØ, and are featured in many, MANY tasks.

Notable tasks: Public Surface, Clever Vandalism, Object Annotation, Find Roof Access

TAKE A PICTURE OF SOMEONE AT THE TOP OF THE CARPARK FROM THE BOTTOM.


MOVE DOWN REGENT ROAD AS FAR AS YOU CAN GO


BEGIN TO MOVE DOWN MARINE PARADE TOWARD THE SEALIFE CENTRE


REMAIN ON THE BEACH


TAKE THE BACKROADS UNTIL YOU REACH TRAFALGAR ROAD
